Reflexión: Hace Oír a Los Sordos y Hablar a Los Mudos

La invitación hoy es comenzar a orar y buscar ver el rostro de Dios, hacer silencio para escucharle. Exprésale todo lo que hay en tu corazón. Él siempre escucha al que lo busca. Isaías anuncia que, al final de los tiempos, se realizará una nueva creación de Dios: se abrirán nuestros oídos y nuestros labios, porque su gracia nos curará y nos redimirá de nuestros males. Dios no está mudo ni ciego. Él es buena noticia, luz y pronto auxilio. El Evangelio de este domingo nos recuerda nuestro Bautismo, entrada a la familia de Dios. Al que es bautizado se le signa con la cruz los oídos diciéndole: “¡Ábrete!” Es un signo de la disposición de escuchar y aprender. El egoísmo, la avaricia, la incompreensión, la violencia, la intolerancia, la infidelidad, son frutos de un querer vivir en sobreabundancia desmedida, un gran tapón al Evangelio. Jesús ha venido a salvarnos de todo ello, invitándonos en la Carta del apóstol Santiago a que demos un paso más en la verdadera fe: recuperar la importancia de escuchar, acoger y atender a los pobres, referencia y comprobante de quien ha escuchado en verdad la voz de Dios. La comunicación por los sentidos debe llevar a la comunión con Dios y los hermanos, todo referido a Dios y a los demás, no centrados en nosotros mismos. Primero, escuchar, y después hablar. Jesús nos tendría que curar también a nosotros, porque a veces somos sordos y mudos. No oímos lo que tendríamos que oír: la Palabra de Dios, o también las palabras de nuestros hermanos. Y no hablamos lo que tendríamos que hablar: la alabanza a Dios y también nuestras palabras de ayuda a los hermanos. Un cristiano tiene que saber escuchar y saber hablar a su tiempo. Ser seguidores de Jesús no sólo es saber y creer cosas sobre Él, sino imitar Su estilo de actuación en la vida. Desde hace dos mil años la Iglesia, la comunidad de los seguidores de Jesús, no sólo se goza en ser curada por Jesús sino de transmitir esa misma fuerza sanadora.

Señor que oiga y viva tu Palabra con el ejemplo para el bien de la familia y de la Parroquia.

Reflect: Spiritual Deafness

Most of us think that blindness is worse than deafness. Helen Keller, who was both blind and deaf, said deafness is the greater handicap. When you are totally deaf, a door to the world around you closes. You begin to feel lonely and abandoned. You become a stranger in your own land. The Scottish theologian William Barclay quotes a prayer written by a deaf person. A portion of it reads: *O God, the trouble with being deaf is that most people find deaf folks a nuisance. They sympathize with people who are blind and lame, but they get irritated and annoyed with people who are deaf. As a result, deaf people are apt to avoid other people and become isolated from the hearing world.* That poignant prayer gives us an insight into how it feels to be deaf—much less deaf and dumb. That situation is being *spiritually* deaf and dumb. People who are spiritually deaf and dumb are unable to speak to God in prayer, and they are unable to hear God speak to them in the depths of their heart. This spiritual tragedy is as old as the world, but it is increasingly becoming a tragedy in our day. Imagine the feelings and sensations experienced by the deaf man in today's gospel.

Because of Jesus, he is able to hear for the first time in his life! What a mixture of relief and wonder it must have brought to him. And this is not all that has been healed. The impediment to his speech is instantly taken away as his hearing is given to him. He can now speak in a clear and understandable way.

Jesus was constant instructing his disciples to listen, to be attentive, to stretch themselves beyond narrow ways of seeing and hearing. This was not easy, especially when they witnessed miracles that brought people their hearing, their sight, their very lives. Jesus, we put our trust in your healing touch. Unstop our ears and open our hearts to your message of justice, love, and compassion, even when those words challenge us. Remove the impediments from our speech—fear, intimidation, apathy, or doubt. Help us to proclaim our faith loudly and our love for you with gladness. We pray all of this in the name of Jesus Christ. Amen.
