Reflexión:**Jesucristo—Virgen María—Nosotros**

Reflect on the Gospel: The Messiah's Question

“But who do you say that I am?” (Mark 8:29). Peter is quick with an answer to this question. In doing so, he names Jesus as the One, the Messiah, whose coming has been so anticipated. The first point in today's Gospel is the importance of answering the most important question of our lives: Who is Jesus? The second point the Gospel makes is—in some sense—equally important. If I answer the first question as Peter did, what is my answer to the second question, namely, am I willing to pay the price it will cost me to follow Jesus? Jesus put it this way: *“If any of you want to come with me, you must forget yourself, carry your cross, and follow me. For if you want to save your own life, you will lose it; but if you lose your life for me and for the gospel, you will save it. Do you gain anything if you win the whole world but lose your life?”* In other words, how willing am I to step out in faith, as Peter did? How willing am I to pay whatever price it might cost me to get to know Jesus better?

How willing am I to pick up my cross and follow Jesus every day of the week—and not just on Sundays? To put the second point in another way: How does Jesus experience me? Does he experience me the way he experienced Peter as someone who truly wants to follow him? In other words, does Jesus experience me as a follower? Or does Jesus experience me only as an admirer or fan? Does he experience me only as someone who sits on the curb and applauds as he stumbles by carrying his cross alone? These are the two important questions the Gospel puts before each of us today: How do I experience Jesus? And How does Jesus experience me? *It is that way in our own lives. We Christians know, by faith, that there's a man hidden away in every scene of our lives. And that man's name is Jesus. Once we find him and meet him up close and personal, no scene in life will ever be the same again. It will always be special.* **Who do people in today's culture seem to want Jesus to be?** What indications do I see of this in my home, parish, neighborhood, school, or workplace? Read over the last line of the gospel one more time. **What does it say to me at this point in my life? What questions does it raise for me?**
