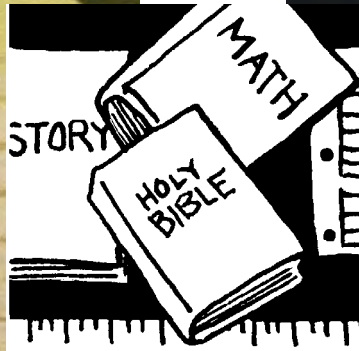
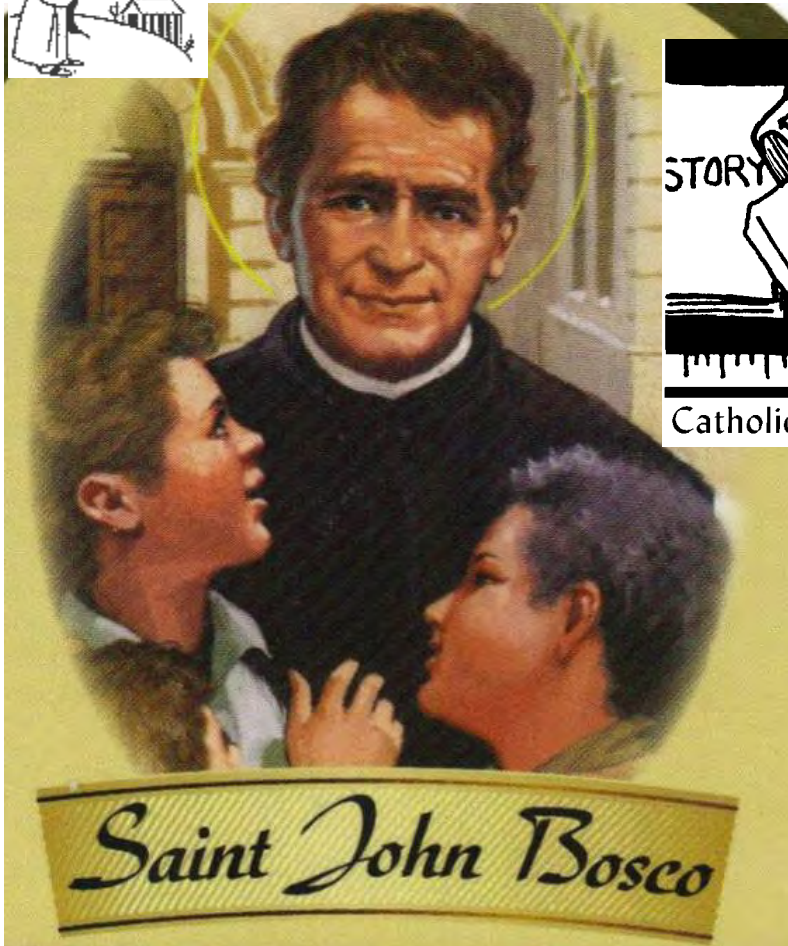

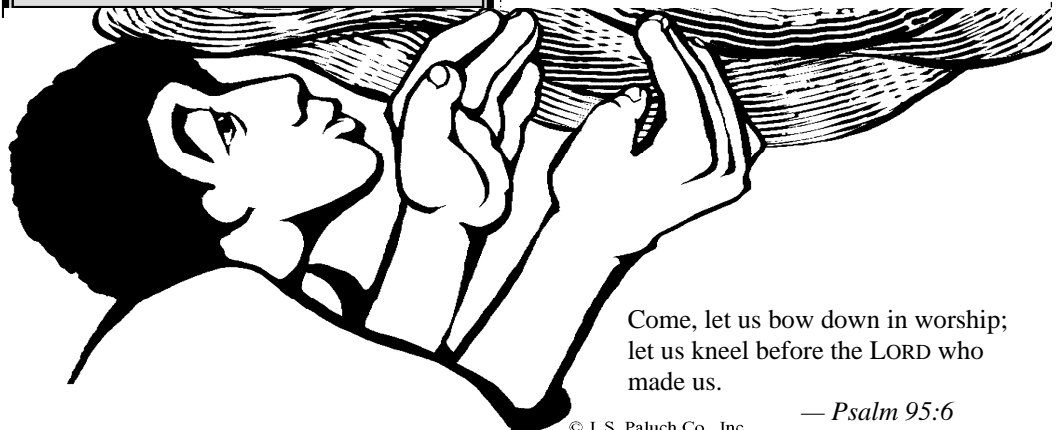

MEDITATION

El peligro de la vida...

Jesucristo vino al mundo para anunciar e inaugurar el reino de Dios. Por el poder de su resurrección has otorgado a su Iglesia, con autoridad, la fuerza divina. La fe de la Iglesia nos conduce hacia la verdad para que seamos liberados de diversos peligros y especialmente del demonio. Nos enseña el Catecismo de la Iglesia Católica (#395) que el poder de Satanás no es infinito. Satanás actúe en el mundo por odio contra Dios y su reino, y su acción cause graves daños –de naturaleza espiritual e, indirectamente, también de naturaleza física– a cada hombre ya a la sociedad. El poder de expulsar o la oración liberación de demonios que Jesús confirió a todos los creyentes conserva toda validez; pero sólo al sacerdote autorizado, además del obispo exorcizante, corresponde el nombre de exorcista. Satanás nos tienta por medio del engaño. la mentora y la confusión. Es homicida porque mata la vida de la gracia en nosotros y, por lo tanto, da muerte a nuestra alma. También hace que el cuerpo perezca, porque “por envidia del diablo entró la muerte en el mundo”. El demonio es seductor. Cumple su labor de seducción presentándose como “ángel de luz” con sus ofertas como deliciosas y convenientes. Así lo hizo con Jesús en las tentaciones en el desierto. La tentación nunca la muestra como algo malo, sino como algo conveniente, bueno y “natural”; y en ese momento “crítico”, la virtud es presentada como “anti-natural”, haciendo entrar en perplejidad al alma que lo escucha. No tenemos que dar oído a sus mentiras seductoras, que hacen aparecer el vicio como un bien y la virtud como algo malo. Hay que hacer directamente lo contrario de lo que sugiere. Desde siempre, desde el inicio, la mentira ha sido su estrategia preferida. No hay lugar a dudas de que el diablo tiene la capacidad de atrapar a muchas personas en las redes de las mentiras, pequeñas o grandes. Engaña a los hombres haciéndoles creer que no tienen necesidad de Dios y que son autosuficientes, sin necesitar ni la gracia ni la salvación. **La Iglesia está segura de la victoria final de Cristo** y, al mismo tiempo, es consciente de la acción de maligno, que trata de desanimarnos y de sembrar la confusión, por lo que no cesa de celebrar la Eucaristía y los sacramentos de la salvación, expresión importante de la lucha contra el maligno. Jesús, que pasó haciendo el bien y sanando a los oprimidos por el mal, nos trae una vida en plenitud del felicidad, alegría, amor, libertad, paz... O Señor, danos el don de discernimiento de espíritus para reconocer tu acción y rechazar la de Satanás. Muchos Santos de la Iglesia como S. Miguel Arcángel, S. Juan Bosco, S. María Faustina nos enseñan como reprender en el nombre de Jesucristo toda tentación y actividad pecaminosa. O Señor Jesús, ayúdanos a vivir contigo.

Recognizing...

The people in this story were just learning who Jesus was. So they were still blind to the amazing truth of it. Others saw more clearly, however. The unclean spirits recognized him. His enemies recognized his power and were threatened by it. The centurion who saw him hanging on the cross saw and proclaimed him truly to be the Son of God. But the people closest to him, his disciples, seemed to take the longest to realize who Jesus was. Like the disciples, each of us has some partial blindness to the truth. We carry with us a bias toward our own insights, our own views, our own opinions. Like the disciples, this can make it difficult for us to recognize what is real and true and good. What might we learn from this? Perhaps we can learn to ask if it's typical of us not to recognize the goodness in those close to us but see it more easily in others. Is it easier for us to believe that Jesus was present to the people in the story we just read than to believe that Christ is present to us in our daily life? Like the disciples, sometimes we miss what is right before us because it is right before us. Maybe we are blind to the presence of Christ with us in our homes, in our work, and as we move through our errands and tasks each day. Do we recognize Jesus Christ in our life? We see how Jesus taught the people in the synagogue. First he taught by his words. Then Jesus taught by his actions. He spoke angrily to the evil one and relieved the man with the unclean spirit. Words and actions combined to make a powerful statement. Jesus is giving us an example and a challenge. We too are to try to match our lives, our actions, to what we say we believe. Where are we showing, by what our community does, that we believe the words we profess? Where are we not doing this as well? How can we improve? With S. John Bosco, S. Mary Faustina we have help in recognizing who is Jesus in our life. O Lord, guide our feet that they may stay on the path of the gospel, the way that Jesus the teacher has shown us.

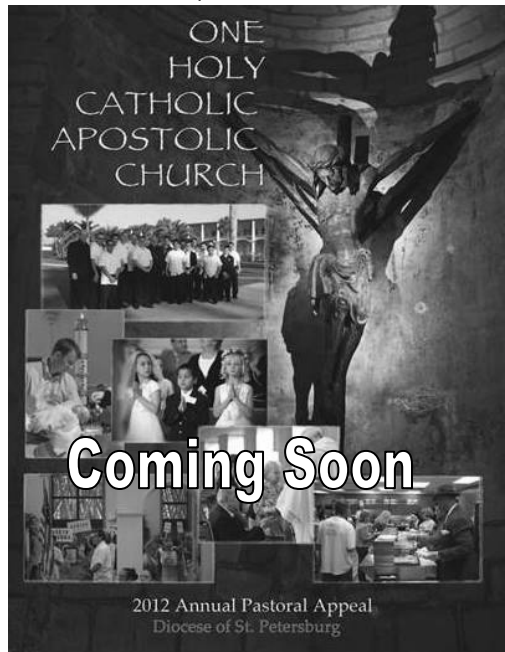

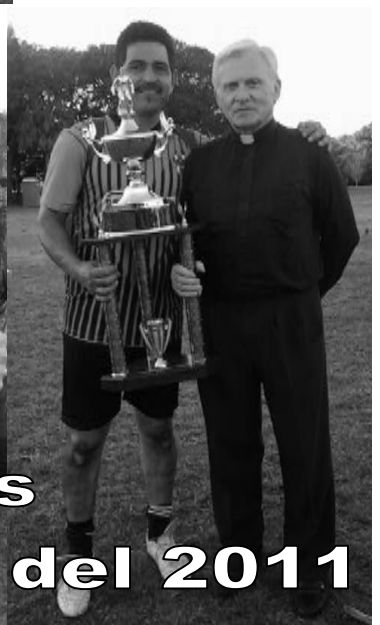
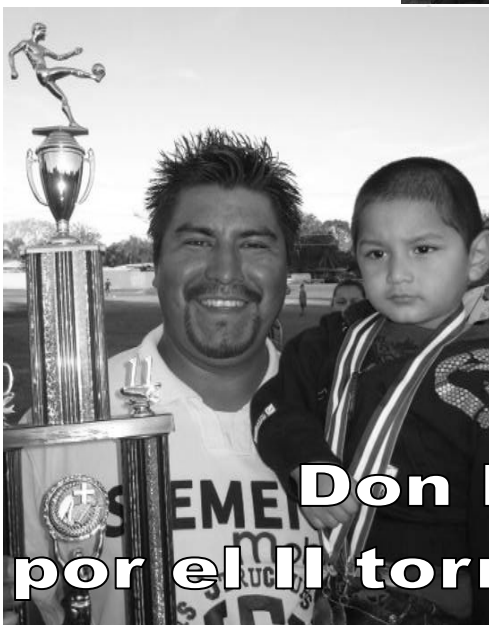
